<b>Affiliates, Volunteers, Contracted Workers &amp; Alumnae</b>	<b>Yes - but only while traveling for or working on behalf of MIT</b>
<b>Recent Graduates</b>	<b>Yes - if on a continuation of a MIT program enrolled in prior to Graduation. (Unless otherwise agreed to -only for 3 months after).</b>
